

## Opportunity Description Helpdesk Specialist

Suburban Health Organization is a physician and hospital network serving central Indiana. We seek a part-time Helpdesk Specialist. The Help Desk Specialist will be responsible for the primary support of the SHO help desk for the company, staff, and guests. The Help Desk Specialist will help with the monitoring and maintenance of SHO systems, including but not limited to the network (LAN, WAN, WLAN), cloud services (including Exchange Online, SharePoint Online, OneDrive, Teams, etc.) laptops, mobile devices, phones, and multi-function copiers and printers. The Help Desk Specialist will also monitor and maintain daily and monthly backups.

## Primary Responsibilities

- Professionally represents SHO to the owners, business partners, clients, and customers

- Maintains an effective working relationship with all employees, customers, and owners

- Maintain SHO backup procedures and ensure successful backups are achieved
- Work closely with Manager of Information Technology to support the initiatives of the IT Department Strategic Plan and IT project-related request tracking
- Create and Maintain IT documentation as appropriate
- Act as a liaison between end users and IS/IT Staff
- Occasional on call may be required.
